

**Notice of preparation of new Electoral (Membership) Roll
for the parish of St Marylebone with Holy Trinity, St Marylebone**

Notice is hereby given that under the Church Representation Rules a new Church Electoral Roll is being prepared. All persons who wish to have their names entered on the new Roll, whether their names are entered on the present Roll or not, are requested to apply for enrolment not later than:

12th March

The new Roll will come into operation on:

26th March 2019

Renewal of Parish Church's electoral (membership) roll

2019 sees the preparation of new church electoral rolls throughout England. This means that everyone already enrolled must come off the roll and re-apply. New names may be added.

This takes place only once in every six years.

A person will be entered onto the roll if they have:

(i) been baptised and are aged 16 or over and have signed a form of application for enrolment;

and are, either:

(iii) a member of the Church of England or of any Church in communion with the Church of England and are resident in the parish

or (if not resident in the parish) have regularly attended public worship in the parish during the six months prior to their application for enrolment;

A person will be entered onto the roll if they:

(iv) are a member in good standing of a Church (not in communion with the Church of England) which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity declaring themselves to be also members of the Church of England and having attended public worship in the parish during the six months prior to their application for enrolment.

Any error discovered in the Roll should at once be reported to the undersigned.
